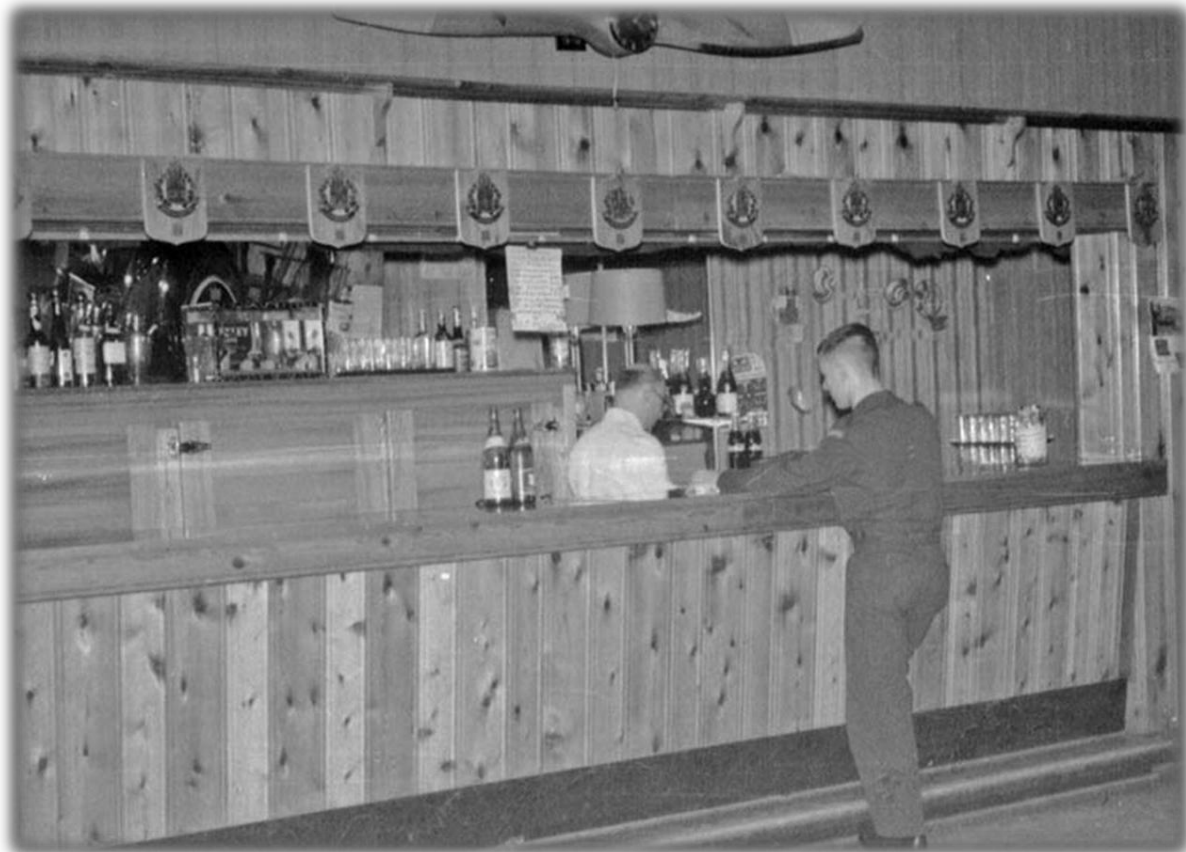

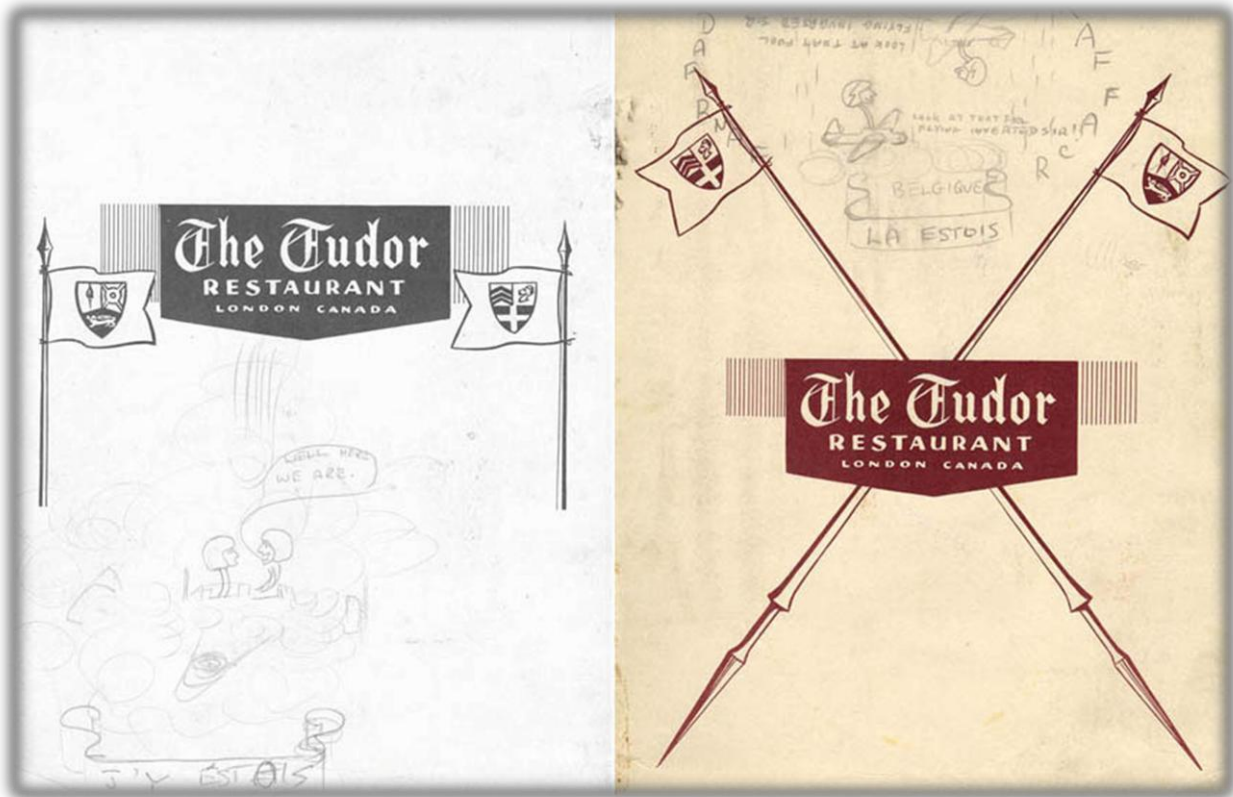

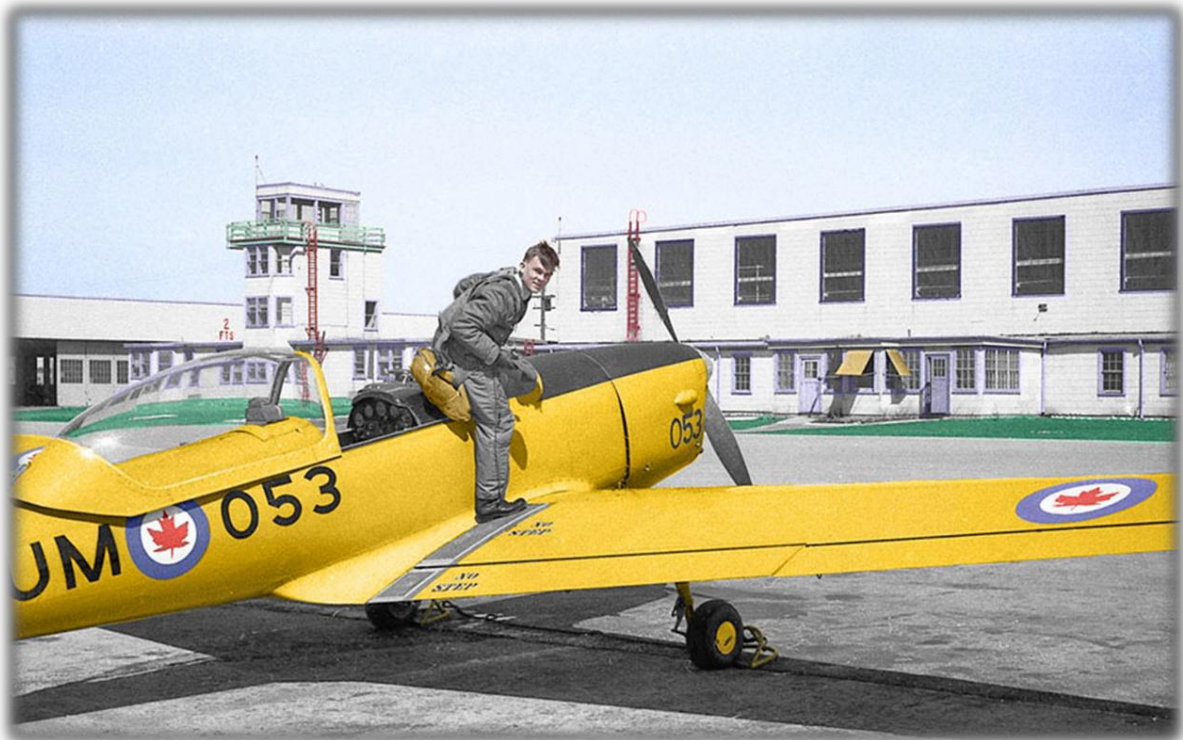

PILOT'S CHECK LIST  
 CIRCUIT HT (IND)

CRIPMUNK

JULY 1956



TARMAC CHECK *Go round in this order*

1. Radio. *turn it on.*
2. Adjust harness.
3. No loose articles.
4. Hand fire extinguisher fastened (front cockpit)
5. Elevator trim full travel.
6. Hand brake - functions properly.
7. Instruments.
8. Carb. heat.
9. Primer locked.
10. Flap - functions properly.
11. Fuel contents change to right tank.
12. Unnecessary switches off, circuit breakers in.
13. Check for dead magneto.
14. Call Tower. Radio Taxi etc.
15. Maps.

OG-RHIDS etc.

GIN-UP CHECK

1. Tail wheel on runway, brakes on. *Flaps up*
2. Fuel on right tank.
3. Temp., and Pressures.
4. All clear ahead and behind.
5. C.C. fully back.
6. Open throttle 1500 RPM, check mags. (Max. drop 100 RPM) carb. heat Generator.
7. Open throttle fully, check RPM approx. 1925. Check temps and pressures.
8. If a drop of more than 100 RPM was indicated on initial mag. check throttle back to 1600 and re-check.

PRE TAKE-OFF - PRE LANDING CHECKS

1. E. Harness hood. *down*
2. T. (a) Trim - *down* when both cockpits occupied slightly tail heavy when solo from front cockpit.
- (b) Tension
- (c) Temperatures
3. Mixture - carb. heat
4. E. Fuel *HT MPFFC*
5. F. Flap
6. G. Gyros
7. Switches

PRE LANDING (DOWNWIND)

1. Brakes off.
2. Fuel
3. Mixture, carb. heat
4. Harness and hood
5. Speed 65K.

PRE LANDING - BASE LEG

1. Flap as required

AFTER LANDING

1. Flap up *Pitot heat*

1) Stays straight  
 2) Solo field  
 3) Full checks  
 4) Full checks mag

FREE SPIN - STALL - LOW FLYING AND AEROBATIC CHECKS

1. Harness, Hood.
2. Trim for level flight.
3. Mixture, carb. heat.
4. Fuel.
5. Flaps.
6. Gyros caged.
7. Brakes off.
8. Loose objects.
9. Sufficient altitude.
10. Locality.
11. Lookout.

O/P 40-45  
 Env. min 30

FORCED LANDING AND FIRE CHECKS

1. F. Fuel.
2. M. Mixture, carb. heat.
3. S. Switches.

REAL ACTION CHECK

1. Fuel off.
2. Switches off.
3. Harness tight and locked.
4. Hood open.
5. Flap as required.

FIRE IN AIR OR ON GROUND

1. Throttle closed.
2. Fuel off.
3. Switches off.

SHUTTING DOWN CHECK

Check Dead Carburetor

- Idle at approx 800 RPM for at least 30 seconds (1 minute in summer). *Good to stop descent*
- Switch ignition off.
- Immediately open throttle fully.
- Fuel off.
- Switches off.
- Throttle closed.
- Brakes set.
- Gyros caged.
- Radio off.

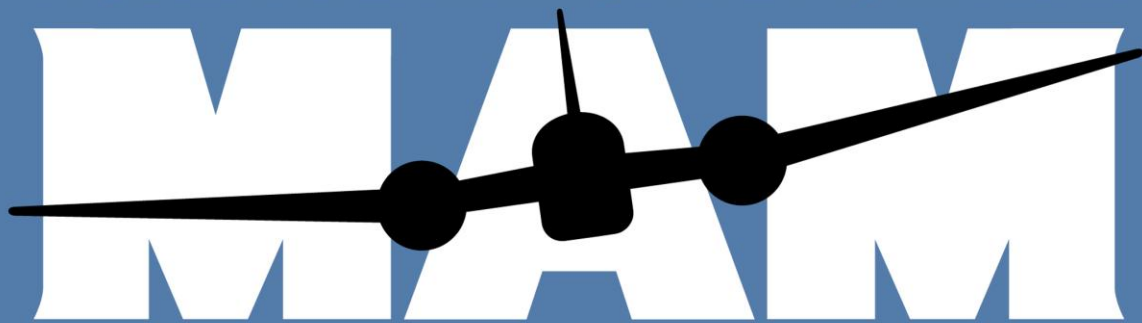

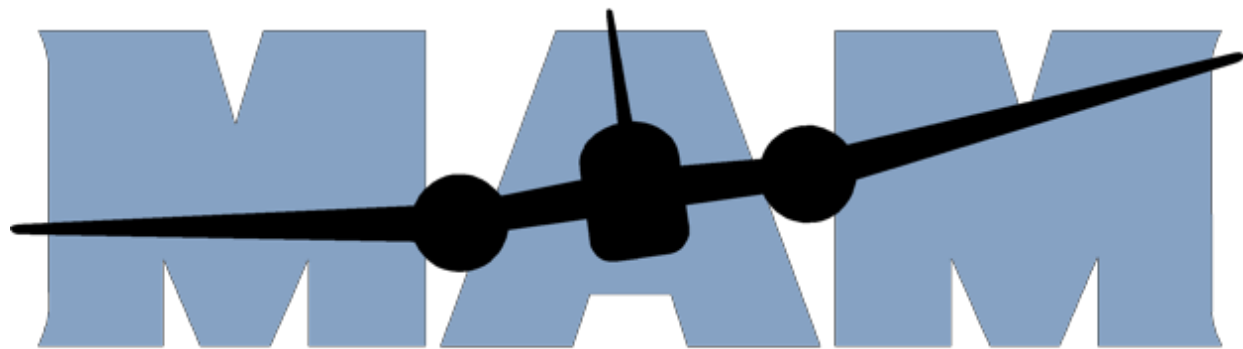
